 3. **A copy of your high school transcript, diploma, HiSET or GED.**
 4. **A copy of your qualifying test scores** (SAT, ACT and/or ACCUPLACER). For more information, visit www.smccME.edu/tests.
 5. **Official college transcripts** (if applicable).
