How to Apply

- Submit the following materials to the SMCC Admissions Office by mail to 2 Fort Road, South Portland, ME 04106 or by fax to 207-741-5760 or email to admissions@smccME.edu.
 - Application - Complete and mail the attached application or apply online at www.smccME.edu/apply
 - \$20 nonrefundable application fee
 - A copy of your high school transcript, diploma, HiSET or GED
 - Official college transcripts (if applicable)

- Complete the English and Math ACCUPLACER Tests (if applicable).

Students who have any of the following test scores and/or previous college coursework are exempt from the English portion of the ACCUPLACER and will be placed into college-level English.

- SAT: 480 or greater Evidence-Based Reading and Writing (ERW)
- ACT: 21 or greater Composite
- Successful completion of a college-level English Composition course from a regionally accredited institution

Students who have any of the following test scores and/or previous college coursework are exempt from the Math portion of the ACCUPLACER and will be placed into college-level math.

- SAT: 500 or greater Math
- ACT: 21 or greater Composite
- Successful completion of a college-level mathematics courses from a regionally accredited institution



