

# ADMISSIONS CHECKLIST



## To Apply to SMCC:

- **Complete the English and Math ACCUPLACER Tests (if applicable).**

Students who have any of the following test scores and/or previous college coursework are exempt from the English portion of the ACCUPLACER and will be placed into college-level English.

  - SAT: 480 or greater Evidence-Based Reading and Writing (ERW)
  - ACT: 21 or greater Composite
  - Successful completion of a college-level English Composition course from a regionally accredited institution

Students who have any of the following test scores and/or previous college coursework are exempt from the Math portion of the ACCUPLACER and will be placed into college-level math.

  - SAT: 530 or greater Math
  - ACT: 21 or greater Composite
  - Successful completion of a college-level mathematics courses from a regionally accredited institution

- **For students who are:**

- **Look for your acceptance letter in the mail. Along with this you will receive a Guide for Accepted Students which you should carefully review.** If you haven't received an acceptance letter and are wondering if you have missing requirements, visit [www.smccME.edu](http://www.smccME.edu), click MySMCC in the upper left-hand corner and follow the login instructions to sign into your student portal. After signing in, go to the "Admissions" tab, and find "Missing Admission Requirements." Click "View Folder Items" to see your missing requirements.
- **Apply for Financial Aid (optional) by completing the FAFSA online at [www.fafsa.gov](http://www.fafsa.gov).** Our school code is 005525. You can begin applying after October 1 (priority deadline is May 1).
- **Interested in living on Campus?** SMCC has two residence halls on its South Portland Campus and one at the Midcoast Campus in Brunswick. Visit My Student Life on the MySMCC portal to view and complete the online housing application. You are eligible to complete the housing application after you've registered for classes. If you register for classes by the second week in June you are guaranteed housing. Applications for Housing are typically processed alongside course registration in November for spring accepts and in May for fall accepts.
